

In a village near the Pacific Ocean in El Salvador, the people of **San Luis Talpa** live a simple life. Most families live on only a few dollars a day—*woefully* little to cover housing, a healthy diet, medical care, clothes, and education.



The **Vision of God Clinic** makes a big difference for the adults and children in the community. From a church basement, it serves as a center where people can access medical supplies and basic health care services, food, clothing, and help with children's education.

Members and friends of **Bethel United Church of Christ** in Arlington, Virginia, and **La Luz Verdadera**, which uses Bethel's building, donate funds needed to staff the clinic with a doctor.

The two congregations also collect first-aid supplies; over-the counter medicines such as pain relievers; vitamins; clothing; and other items that are transported periodically to the clinic.
